There are two readings a day, one from the Book Exodus and the other from the Gospel of Matthew. Exodus deals with the events leading up to and after the first Passover. Matthew deals with the events leading up to and after the first New Covenant Passover. These readings begin on March 9 and finish on April 7.

Each scripture reading is preceded by a short introduction. These introductions are based on the section headings of several Bibles I own. Some are direct quotes, and others are not.
